Quality Assurance

Training syllabus
Medi Aid's FAW courses includes the syllabus stated by HSE in published guidance. The courses last at least 18 hours, over 3 days as recommended by HSE.
Medi Aid's FAW requalification course includes the syllabus stated by HSE in published guidance. The courses last at least 12 hours, over two days.
Medi Aid's EFAW course includes the syllabus stated by HSE in published guidance. The courses last at least six hours.
Medi Aid's EFAW requalification is the same course as the EFAW above. The courses last at least six hours.
Certificates
Medi Aid's certificates are issued to students assessed as competent contain the name Medi Aid (UK) Ltd, the title of the qualification (e.g. FAW or EFAW), reference to the Health and Safety (First-Aid) Regulations 1981, the date of issue and confirmation the certificate is valid for three years.
